Dear Valued Nashua Customer,

Re: Nashua service delivery during the Lockdown of South Africa due to COVID-19

In light of the rapidly developing situation globally and here in South Africa with the spread of the COVID-19 virus, Nashua wishes to assure you that it will take all measures within its control to act fast and to implement measures to reduce the spread of the virus, in accordance with President Cyril Ramaphosa's call for a complete lockdown in order to curtail the spread of the said virus.

As a result of the lockdown, Nashua's business operations will close its warehouse and delivery from 17:00 on Thursday 26 March 2020 and will re-open operations on 17 April 2020. With effect from Friday 27 March 2020, no deliveries will be possible. All purchase orders not delivered will go on back order with Nashua and will only be delivered after 17 April 2020.

Note that if your business operations fall within the published essential services or is excluded from the lockdown, Nashua will continue to supply your business on an "emergency, stand by basis" and request that you urgently communicate with your Nashua account representative or the signatory in this regard.

These above measures will be in place for the foreseeable future and we will continue to be assessed and will be subject to further changes as required and in line with governmental guidance.

We will continue to update you on the situation as and when circumstances change.
